Pakistan Dates

Pakistan is ranked at 6^{th} position in Dates Production, 5^{th} position in Area under Dates Fruit and 8^{th} position in Dates Export in the world. Date fruit is the 3^{rd} largest horticulture crop of Pakistan, found in all four provinces on 99 thousand hectares with production of around 540,000 tons annually

There are four major clusters of Dates production in Pakistan, namely at Sukkur and Khairpur in Sindh; Turbat and Panjgur in Balochistan; Muzaffargarh, Jhang, Multan, Bahawalpur and D.G Khan in Punjab and Dera Ismail Khan in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Dates Usage and its Value Added Products



Mostly, the fresh dates (whole or pitted) of select grade are used for table fruit. However, in many countries including in Pakistan the seeds from the soft fresh dates are manually or through pitting machine driven out and replaced with dry fruits like almonds, walnuts, pistachio etc., while some pressed it to make block, bars and chopped dates.



Dried dates (natural or colored) are used for both domestic (to eat) as well industrial (powder) purposes. The dry dates powder is mostly used for confectionary, bakery and other food products.



There are various uses of dates in the industry include dates paste, dates syrup, dates powder, dates juice, dates honey, dates vinegar, dates jams, beverage extract, sauces, pickles, desserts, confectionary items, bakery items, liquid/powder sugar and alcohol etc.
