## PRODUCT PROFILE

Pakistan produces over 2.3 million tons of onions annually, making it one of Asia's top onion-growing nations. Sindh and Balochistan lead the charge, offering early and late-season harvests that ensure year-round availability. Pakistani onions are prized for their strong aroma, long shelf life, and vibrant red-purple color.

Popular varieties include Phulkara, Swat Local, and Desi Red-each suited for local cuisine and export demand. With a growing cold chain and modern packaging, Pakistan exported over 250,000 tons of onions last year. Top export destinations include UAE, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Oman, and the Gulf region.


