PRODUCT PROFILE

Honey is a natural, energy-rich food containing sugars (fructose, glucose), proteins, amino acids, vitamins, enzymes, minerals, antioxidants, and trace elements. Its main sugars, fructose and glucose, are directly absorbed into the bloodstream, providing instant energy. Honey is widely used for nutrition, medicines, cosmetics, and natural remedies.

Pakistan has highly favorable ecological zones for beekeeping, allowing production of some premium and export-demanded honey varieties including Sidr (Ber), Acacia, Citrus, Multiflora, and Wild Mountain honey.
